Richard Le Corrone for the Poterie de CIBOURE Stoneware baluster vase with beige, brown and black enamel decoration. Traditional subject of Basque dancers in front of an Etxea in a Pyrenean landscape Signed on the bottom of the belly, marked RF CIBOURE under the base H.: 21 -Diam.: 15 cm Very good condition Ciboure is a town in Nouvelle Aquitaine located in the Pyrénées-Atlantiques. A pottery was active there from 1919 to 1995. The pottery building was installed in a former whaleboat cellar on the banks of the Nivelle in the current Golf district. Richard Le Corrone (1909-1977) joined the pottery in 1928. From this period, he composed, in a lively, very recognizable style, Basque scenes, inspired by dances or field work.
