His real name is Julien Alphonse Leclerc, a French designer and painter. He studied at the École des Arts Décoratifs in Paris. From 1918 onwards, he worked very regularly with newspapers and magazines: La Vie Parisienne, La Baïonnette, Le Sourire, Paris Plaisirs, Bagatelle, Fantasio, Le Rire, L'Esprit de Paris, L'Illustration etc ... He exhibited regularly at the Salon des Artistes Français (paintings, pastels) and also at the Salon des Humoristes from 1920 to 1935 (humorous drawings).
