Thonet Art Nouveau bent beech table model no. 9171 with palmettes, Austria, circa 1910 Stained in American mahogany Very good condition with its Thonet Wien label under the tabletop = Thonet, founded in 1819 by Michael Thonet in Germany, is the oldest furniture manufacturer in the world. Specializing in the Biedermeier style, it distinguished itself from the 1830s onwards by its innovative steam-bent wood technique. In 1842, he was invited to Vienna, Austria, by Prince Metternich, where he founded Gebrüder Thonet with his sons. Chair No. 14, created around 1859, revolutionized industrial furniture production with its lightness and ease of assembly. Thonet established itself in European and American cafés. In the 20th century, it adopted tubular steel with the Bauhaus designers.
