Beautiful pair of cabriolet armchairs in finely molded and carved wood, gendarme hat back, fluted rudenté legs. Superb Louis XVI style silk lampas cover with fine floral decoration on a sky blue background (Marie Antoinette silk by Tassinari and Chatel). Stamp of Paul-François Jean, Louis XVI period circa 1784-1789. Paul-François Jean - seat carpenter. Received master on October 5, 1784 and active until 1789. He practiced on rue du Faubourg-Saint-Antoine under the name of "Saint-Esprit". He made luxury seats, with the assistance of the sculptors Joigny, Cresson, Duclos and Mancien. We recognize the characteristics of a great master carpenter in seats: perfect proportions, flawless execution with very careful details: rosettes of the connecting dice in relief, very fine sculpture in water leaf and
