Description

- Masonic solid silver regulator pocket or pocket watch from the watch brand James Favre-Fallet located in Saint-Imier in French-speaking Switzerland in the canton of Bern. French chimera hallmark of 800/1000 fineness expressed in thousandths for imported watchmaking in use in France from May 10, 1838 to June 30, 1893. - This hallmark is stamped on foreign watches in solid silver presented in Paris (according to cutting) and departure (with different). - This import and fineness hallmark was replaced on July 1, 1893 by the swan import and fineness hallmark. The chimera hallmark is present on the bowl, the dust cover and the edge of the regulator watch case with the different letter P (departure) inside the chimera hallmark on the top at the level of the rear end of the chimera. The letter P

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corresponds to the different of the precious metals guarantee office of Pontarlier in the department of Doubs (25). - Dial in polychrome radiant white enamel painted with indexes in Masonic symbols for the hours and graduation with indexes for the minutes. - Dial with the mention painted in black regulator, Swiss made, and the letters ALGDGADLU which is the abbreviation of: To the glory of the great architect of the universe. Two other letters are present, .J. In a column at nine o'clock and .B. in another column at three o'clock, for Jakin and Boaz and these are the two columns of the temple of Solomon. - The two columns of the temple of Solomon symbolize in particular stability, support and duality. - Louis XV hands in gilded metal for the hours and minutes. - Small seconds dial at six o'clock and second hand in gilded steel. Cuvette, edge of the regulator pocket watch and smooth bezel rim, crown winder, gilt brass ball, solid silver bail, slightly domed and beveled mineral glass. - Number 94427-1 engraved in hollow on the dust cover and the cuvette partially erased. - Dust cover chiseled and guilloché with the engraved inscriptions in hollow, anchor escapement, straight line, Bréguet balance spring, winder, 15 jewels no. 94427 and the FJF logo with a star above the letter J of the Swiss watch brand James Favre-Fallet, brand logo registered in the Swiss watch trademark register on 01/16/1890. - Polished steel movement of Swiss manufacture with 15 jewel jeweled anchor escapement, straight line, Bréguet balance spring, advance and retard index located above the balance wheel. - Pendant winder and time setting by pressing the small push button located at the top right next to the pendant head and turning the ball crown winder clockwise at the same time.- In perfect working order, serviced by a watchmaker. - Art Nouveau period, 4th quarter of the 19th century, circa 1890-1893.- Gross weight: 175.67 gr.- Reminder to buyers regarding the right of withdrawal for online purchases on my Proantic website.- Must be read before purchasing on my

Proantic-hosted sales site.- The right of withdrawal applies to sales made on my Proantic sales site. - The withdrawal period is 14 days following the buyer's receipt of the item or goods. - The buyer must notify me via email or by certified mail, without needing to provide a justification or reason, before the 14-day period provided by law following receipt of the package or item.- The buyer has the right to change their mind and has a 14-business-day cooling-off period as provided by this right of withdrawal law, and I respect this right. - After this period, the sale will be considered final and binding. - The costs of returning the item by mail or through a carrier are the buyer's responsibility in the event of withdrawal by the buyer. - The buyer is required to return the item within 14 days of receiving the item or package in its original condition as received, without any breakage or damage to the item and in the same packaging in which it was received, with the same shipping costs and with insurance for the item covering the full sale price listed on my Proantic website, as arranged by the seller, and must provide me via email with the proof-of-deposit receipt issued by the post office when the package or item was dropped off at the post office, or the waybill issued by the carrier.- All sales made on my Proantic website are covered by insurance purchased from La Poste at the time the item or package is shipped, covering loss or theft up to the purchase price paid by the buyer. - La Poste does not cover breakage or damage to the item or object; only theft and loss are covered for package shipping.- Additional insurance covering breakage of the item, up to the price paid by the buyer on my Proantic website, is always purchased from the carrier if the item is shipped by them. - The buyer is subject to legal penalties if they do not return the item within this 14-day period and in good condition.- A refund for the item will be issued within 14 days of the seller's receipt of the item or package and after the condition of the item has been verified. - If

the item or product is found not to be in its original condition, the sale will be considered final with no refund, and the right of withdrawal cannot be exercised. - The refund for the item or product will be issued via the same payment method (check, bank transfer, PayPal) that the buyer used when making the purchase on my Proantic sales site.- The buyer must take the necessary steps on PayPal themselves to request a refund if they paid via PayPal, specifically by going to the "Disputes" section and opening a dispute case involving themselves, PayPal, and the seller.- This reminder regarding sales on my Proantic store is intended for litigious individuals and those acting in bad faith. - I advise litigious individuals and those acting in bad faith not to purchase anything from my Proantic store; this will prevent me from wasting my time and money on legal proceedings. - Fortunately, most of the time my sales on the Proantic site go very smoothly, with customers who are generally friendly, pleasant, and acting in good faith. - Best regards, - Mr. Pineaud.
