Iranian rug from the Fars region (southwest Iran), wool, cotton warp and weft, circa 1950. Very good condition. On a red background, different traditional patterns (mahi, göl, boteh) decorate the field of the rug. A beige border featuring zoomorphic snakes symbolizes joy and fertility. The Gashghai confederation includes different tribes. Some examples: the Kashkulis Bozorgs (the big ones), the Kashkulis Kucheks (the small ones), the Shishbolukis (six districts), the Amalehs or Yalamehs (workers, servants of the Khan).
