Alberto GIACOMETTI (1901.1966) Original signed drawing. Ink on heavy paper - 23×16.70 cm Bouquet of flowers. Signed lower right Alberto Giacometti. Stamped Saturday evening, November 22, 1952. Thinking of Paul Éluard. Alberto Giacometti. Moving testimony of the Swiss artist remembering his surrealist friend Paul Éluard, struck down by a heart attack a few days earlier, on November 18, 1952. Éluard's funeral took place on the same November 22 at the Père Lachaise cemetery.
