Description

Konosuke Hoshizaki (active 1920-1940) Bouquet of Lilacs and Hydrangeas in a Vase, Parisian Interior Oil on cardboard, 61 × 50 cm, 71 cm x 66 cm. Signed lower right "Hoshizaki", original antique frame (small losses and restorations). In the hushed atmosphere of a Parisian interior, a large glazed vase with blue-green highlights holds a sumptuous bouquet mixing mauve and white lilacs and pink hydrangeas. The abundant corollas, rendered by generous impasto, fill the composition and seem to vibrate under a subdued light. The decorative sobriety of the background--painted panels and woodwork--highlights the floral luxuriance and underlines the balance between architectural rigor and freedom of touch. Konosuke Hoshizaki belongs to the generation of Japanese painters
