Description

Elegant and robust, this solid acacia port chest of drawers embodies the refinement of the Louis XV period in its second half of the 18th century. Originating from the Vannes region, it subtly evokes the curved lines of crossbow chests of drawers, while asserting its maritime character through the solidity of its wood and the richness of its ornaments. It opens with three large identical drawers, each adorned with finely worked bronze handles and entries. The uprights are highlighted by a molding with a recess, while the crosspieces, also molded, add to the harmony of the whole. The piece of furniture rests on front legs called "snails", typical of the Louis XV aesthetic, which give it a look that is both graceful and assertive. This chest of drawers is a reflection of Breton craftsmanship and 18th
