R Sougen" Date: 1915 (inscribed on the reverse) Dimensions: $13.5 \times 10 \text{ cm (view)}$ -22.5 × 19.5 cm (framed) Framing: gilded baguette frame with hammered decoration with ecru painted rebate, in very good general condition Small intimate marine typical of Jean René Sourgen: a section of Landes beach and its dune cord in the foreground, marram grass and scrub greened by the sea spray, the Atlantic sea in green-blue hues in horizontal bands, and a cloudy sky streaked with light. "Pochade" format characteristic of the 1910s for the artist, seeking to capture the changing atmosphere of the coastline (Mimizan / Biscarrosse / Capbreton). Very good condition. Clean surface, fine patina of use, minimal drying marks and minor age-related
