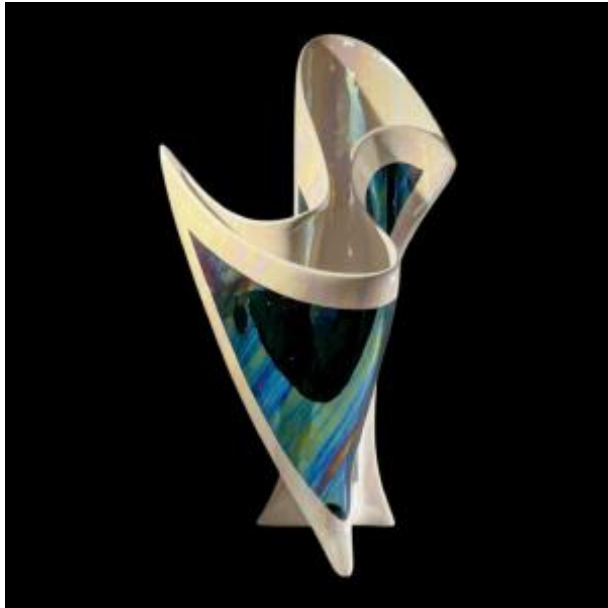




Iridescent Free-form Sculptural Ceramic Vase

Description

Ceramic vase with free and sculptural form, Italy, post-war period Vase decorated with a black painted motif on a white background, under an iridescent glaze animated by changing reflections ranging from blue to green. This type of treatment gives the surface a luminous and moving appearance, characteristic of Italian decorative research of the post-war period. The attribution of this piece remains open: its aesthetic recalls both the production of the Verceram factory (active in the 1960s-1970s) and that of Camillo Lusso (1919-1990, Turin), whose abstract forms and experimental finishes present a real stylistic proximity.
