Description

Oil on canvas by Clovis Terraire, depicting this artist's favorite subject: cows grazing in a meadow. In the background is a village nestled in dense vegetation, placed in front of a mountain, probably in Dauphiné or Bugey, regions that Terraire liked to depict. A thin strip of sky with a few clouds floating above it occupies the top of the painting. The work is signed lower left. The colors are strong, and the work is in very good condition. There are no restorations noted. The work is offered in a beautiful carved and painted wooden frame, in good condition (one repair at the bottom right). The artist Clovis Frédérick Léopold Terraire was born in Marseille in 1858 but spent most of his life in Lyon. He exhibited at the Salon de Lyon as well as the Salon des Artistes Français.
