Painting signed Jules Massé (1825-1899) Oil on canvas - Elegant scene at the theater Dimensions without frame: 27.5×41 cm Dimensions with frame: 44×56 cm This refined composition illustrates a 19th-century high society scene: two elegant women, adorned in white and gold dresses enhanced with flowers, descend a theater or opera staircase. Around them, the guests gather, chatting in a richly draped interior. The warm light from the wall lights and the red velvet of the staircase reinforce the hushed atmosphere of this high society moment. Jules Massé's precise and delicate touch highlights the refinement of the costumes, the discreet animation of the groups and the charm of fin-de-siècle Parisian society. A 19th-century artist, Massé distinguished himself with his
