Helvetia Watch, 70s. Helvetia is a historic Swiss watch brand, initially a registered trademark of Louis Brandt & Frere (the parent company of Omega) in 1880, to become the main brand of General Watch Company in the 1930s. After becoming an independent company of Omega in 1911, Helvetia developed its own internal movements and was a well-known manufacturer of military watches throughout the mid-20th century. Movement caliber 873, 17 jewels. Date at 3 o'clock which triggers regularly, seconds in the center. Power reserve of about 48 hours It works very well. Stainless steel back. 35 mm square metal case.
