Description

Beautiful still life with dahlias, in warm colors from the end of the 19th or beginning of the 20th century. It is signed lower right by Marcel de Chollet. He was born in 1855 in Geneva or Morges and died in 1924. Painter of still lifes, watercolorist, decorator. De Chollet received his artistic education from De Borchgrave and Bidan and also followed the advice of P.-V. Galland, at the École des Beaux Arts in Paris. He was still exhibiting at the Salon des Artistes Français, in Paris, in 1923. Among his most important works, we must mention his decorations for the Louvre stores, as well as those of the Terminus café, in Paris. In Geneva, he decorated the theater and in Lausanne, the large courtroom of the federal courthouse on Mont-Benon. Let us also mention, in Bern, the paintings of the former federal palace
