Description

Rare romantic drawing illustrating the novel "Notre-Dame de Paris" by Victor HUGO, we find the court of miracles gathered there at nightfall: Esmeralda, recognizable by her tambourine and her goat, dances by the fire, while stands the evil silhouette of a gallows in the center of the composition and, in the background, the majestic Notre-Dame cathedral. According to our research ("C.Daubigny et son oeuvre gravé" by Frédéric Henriet, 1875 - see last pic), an illustrated version of "Notre-Dame de Paris" appeared in 1844 (Perrotin publisher), decorated with 20 steel and wood engravings by Charles-François DAUBIGNY and other artists.DAUBIGNY thus produced "Esmeralda in front of Notre-Dame", "the dungeon of Esmeralda" or even "the gibbet of Montfaucon". We did not find this drawing in

the illustrated book, it could however be an illustration essay ultimately not retained. The work is signed in ink DAUBIGNY at the bottom right, went to auction in 1994 "attributed to DAUBIGNY" when the subject had not been identified (simply titled "night scene"!!). The style corresponds well to that of certain drawings by DAUBIGNY of the same period.
