Buddha of prosperity. Protective figure seated cross-legged, symbolically round and oversized belly. The hands envelop this prominent belly, the head sunk into the shoulders seeming to rest on it. The expression is concentrated, internalized. The figure rests on a squat base with straight sides, which accentuates the impression of stability and mass. Wood, remains of gilding, some small minor chips of time, old patinas and marks of use. Burmese workshop, late 19th - early 20th century. Dimensions: 10.2 × 6.7 cm.
