Late 19th century Many busts, including ours, are based on the iconography of paintings by Domenico Michelino in 1465 and Sandro Botticelli around 1495. A souvenir of the Grand Tour Iconography linked to archaeological discoveries was a popular theme for Italian artists in the 19th century. Mostly intended for the English and French, these small objets were intended to be taken to neighbouring countries as a souvenir of the trip to Italy. There is a whole production linked to this trip, such as small mosaics, marble busts and so on. Local bronzemakers and
