Vincenzo Gemito, "Bust of a Neapolitan Girl," signed, 1913/1920 Vincenzo Gemito (Naples, 1852-1929), one of the greatest Italian sculptors of the late 19th and early 20th centuries, was renowned for his extraordinary ability to capture the vitality and expressiveness of ordinary Neapolitan subjects. Period: 1913-1920. Material: Dark patinated bronze, with a glossy finish that enhances the anatomical softness and naturalistic rendering of the skin. Dimensions: 40 x 46 x 26 cm. Description: The bust depicts a young Neapolitan woman, captured in a natural and intense pose. Her face is turned in profile to the right, with strongly characterized features, a penetrating gaze, and a concentrated and proud expression. Her hair is gathered in a simple, compact chignon, with great attention to the
