He studied at the École Supérieure des Beaux-Arts and held his first exhibition at the age of 21. Throughout his life, he dedicated himself to painting, working daily in all weather to capture the spirit of Paris.His travels to Holland allowed him to master the techniques of the Flemish masters, which he refined throughout his career.
