Delff's career, when he specialised in rich market and kitchen still lifes, in which human figures were regularly incorporated. Later in his career he solely focussed his attention on the effects of light on metal kitchen vessels. This interest is already visible in the left part of our painting, in the magnificently painted copper kitchen ware.
