Saint Isabel or Saint Elizabeth of Portugal Period between 1271 and 1336...Saint Elizabeth born in 1271 to Peter III of Aragon and Constance of Sicilla. Her Penumbra was given to her in honor of her Aunt Elizabeth of Hungary. In 1282 she married Dinis I of Portugal, a reformer and poet. The King's advisors complained about the Queen's spending on the poor, Dinis decided to ask her what she was hiding in her apron, Elizabeth replied that they were roses????, impossible flowering in January, by opening her apron Roses Appeared like a miracle, since then King Dinis no longer intervened in these Pious Works. She retired to the Monastery of the Poor Clares in COIMBRA after the death of King Dinis in 1325 where she died in 1336, Canonized in 1625 by URBAN VIII before QUEEN SANTA
