Louis-Phillipe Ring in 18ct Gold, foiled, set with 7 Rock Crystal stones, in a Silver setting, as is normal for antique Jewelry of this period. Circa 1838. The Stones are faceted in a Rose cut, forming a Daisy. Rock Crystal is a colourless Quartz, the same family as Citrine and Amethyst. The word "Crystal" comes from the Greek word "Krystallos" meaning ice. Well described! Daisies symbolised loyalty and trust in the past when jewellery was given as tokens of love.
