Description

Portrait miniature of high quality depicts British lady Mrs. Jenkins and it was executed in 1828 by famous British portrait and miniature painter Sir William John Newton (1785 London - 1869 *ibid*). He studied at the Royal Academy Schools from 1807. He may have been a member of a volunteer corps of artists, 1803. Newton exhibited at the R.A. and British Institute in 1808-1863. He was quite popular and had a distinguished clientele, which included many royal and titled persons, members of Parliament and fellow artists. Newton was appointed a miniature painter to William IV and Queen Adelaide in 1833 and painter to Queen Victoria, was knighted in 1837, the year of her access. Provenance: private collection in Paris.
