Description

This magnificent portrait of a Maltese dog was painted in 1863 by the famous Austrian portrait, animal, and genre painter Wilhelm Richter (1824 - Vienna - 1892), who lived and worked in Vienna in the 19th century. He was a student of Thomas Ender and Leopold Kupelwieser at the Vienna Academy. His works are exhibited in various museums and private collections. In the 1840s and 1850s, he traveled to Italy.
