Description

Superb patinated bronze sculpture representing "Education", work by the artist Henri Levasseur (19th century). This allegory full of humanity depicts a woman draped in the antique style, holding a lamp in her right hand, symbolizing the light of knowledge, guiding a young boy leaning against her, open book in hand. The graceful movement, the delicately modeled faces and the draperies of great refinement bear witness to the talent of Levasseur, a sculptor renowned for his elegant allegories and his scenes imbued with gentleness. This bronze is produced by the Société des Bronzes de Paris, a famous Parisian foundry of the late 19th century, guaranteeing impeccable casting quality and magnificent details in the reliefs. The base bears a plaque on the front with the title "EDUCATION".
