Above is a band of marbled blue between gilding. Below is a band of yellow between gilding. The saucer is decorated with a band of marbled blue between gilding, then a wide band of pink and blue florets against a white ground, then a band of yellow between gilding, with a garland of pink and blue flowers centrally. Marks: Interlaced Ls with date letters "gg" for 1784.
