Description

Josef Hoffmann, Wiener Werkstätte - Hammered silver-plated bowl, circa 1905. Rare silver-plated presentation bowl, an original design by Josef Hoffmann (1870-1956), founder of the Vienna Secession and the Wiener Werkstätte. The piece is finely hand-hammered and bears the characteristic hallmarks: the Wiener Werkstätte mark and Josef Hoffmann's stylized monogram JH, guaranteeing its authenticity. With a simple, modern design, emblematic of early 20th-century Viennese aesthetics, this small bowl could have been used as a trinket dish or presentation bowl. Please note: the base shows a circular dent, probably due to contact with an acidic food, without weakening the piece. Dimensions: 14 cm in diameter - 2 cm in height. Weight: 149 g. A rare collector's item, a direct witness to the Vienna
