Pair of solid silver candlesticks, 2nd grade rooster hallmark, department 67 (Antwerp), Empire period Rare pair of solid silver candlesticks, Empire period, hallmarked with the 2nd grade rooster (800/1000) for the period 1798-1809. Each piece bears the department hallmark n°67, corresponding to the city of Antwerp: a head in profile framed by the numbers 6 and 7. This extremely rare hallmark, affixed under the French occupation of Belgium, makes this pair a historical and sought-after testimony to imperial silversmithing. Their slender silhouette, with a faceted shaft resting on a circular base decorated with a laurel frieze, seduces with its purity and astonishing modernity, almost announcing the lines of Art Deco. Their exceptional weight for this type of model underlines the quality of
