Cartel clock, by Barbet, Louis XV period, circa 1735. In oak wood veneered with ebony and decorated with chiseled Rocaille gilded bronzes, resting on arched feet. The case is violinized and surmounted by an allegory of a putti feeding a dragon with a scallop shell. Decorated with interlacing foliage, flowers and cartouches. Signature "BARBET A PARIS" Clockmaker (rue des ours) on the dial and mechanism. Unmodified wire movement in the 19th century!!! In working order, it works in the gallery and regulates very well.
