Elegant pair of iconic LC2 "Grand Confort" armchairs designed in 1928 by Le Corbusier, Pierre Jeanneret and Charlotte Perriand, produced by Cassina. These seats, which have become true classics of modern design, are characterized by their chrome-plated tubular steel structure forming an outer frame, accommodating voluminous black leather cushions. The contrast between the geometric rigor of the frame and the soft comfort of the seat perfectly illustrates the search for balance between function, ergonomics and rational aesthetics specific to the modernist movement.
