With phylactery under the decoration: "SAPO ANIMALIS"*** Sapo animalis: Soap of animal origin, old pharmaceutical excipient for topical use, obtained by saponification of animal fats (sheep, beef...) Historically used for its cleansing, antiseptic properties and as a support for ointments.
