Magnificent pair of large porcelain vases from Mehun-sur-Yèvre by Charles Pillivyut. This is a relief paste-on-paste decoration entirely executed and painted by hand. Slender clematis bloom on the belly of the vases. Bees and butterflies are also part of the decoration. The base is decorated with gold paste trellis in relief. The background is gray enameled with slight pinkish reflections. These are very decorative pieces, rarely seen on the market in this size. Late 19th century period, around 1880-1890, at the beginnings of Art Nouveau. Delivery in a wooden crate on a pallet by carrier on the ground floor in front of your home, 100 euros in France, 200 euros in the EU and 500 euros rest of the world.
