Polychrome Delft earthenware dish, with so-called Orangist* decoration, in the center a landscape with stylized pagodas accompanied by oranges, as well as plant friezes with fruit (olives) on the edge, from the late 18th century. This dish is in good general condition, in its own juice. Please note: some accidents and chips on the edge, some enamel defects, wear and tear, see photos * The Delft factories in the Netherlands, at the end of the 18th century, under the impetus of the independence of the United Provinces and the accession to the throne of the Prince of Orange, created a certain number of decorations on the Orangist theme.
