### Description

French Dagger - France, Revolutionary or First Empire period (late 18th early 19th century) This seems to me to be a military model but I have not been able to identify it. Perhaps it is then a hunting dagger or intended to be worn in society. Three-sided blade with blue and gold engravings (relatively well preserved) on the first two thirds. Fuse covered with copper filigree. Brass guard with two straight quillons ending in a dog's head. Black leather scabbard with brass chape and rivet. The whole mount has a slight play but the whole remains solid and is in fairly good condition. Length 52.5cm Length without scabbard 52cm Blade length 39.5cm Weight 223gr Weight without scabbard 176gr
