Therefore, there are more sparkles. In terms of color, Bohemian crystal was originally forest green. The oldest creations were often adorned with enamel or a subtle gold-colored band. But with the evolution of manufacturing techniques, today we find Bohemian crystal in crystalline white, cobalt blue, red, pink, and even more shades. If you observe the cutting of Bohemian crystal with a magnifying glass, you will notice some slight "imperfections." This is because the cut cannot be uniform.
