Yves Farge (1899-1953) was a multifaceted French artist: painter, journalist, writer, resistance fighter, and politician. Born in Salon-de-Provence, he developed a passion for painting from a young age, particularly during his stays in the Nice countryside where he learned to hold a brush excerpts.numilog.com. His artistic career was shaped by his activism. Alongside his artistic practice, Farge was a major player in the French Resistance. He was made a Companion of the Liberation in 1945 for his decisive role in the fight against the Nazi occupiers, notably by organizing the resistance in the Vercors massif. Museum of the Order of the Liberation. After the war, he continued his commitment as a journalist and politician, founding the Peace Movement in 1948 and directing the newspaper Action. His
