He exhibited at the Salon des Peintres Indépendants in Paris from 1925 He became a member of the Société National des Beaux-Arts in 1930 Hidden during the war because he was persecuted for his origins, it was after this that he devoted himself entirely to painting. A tireless traveler, he traveled the world from 1948, eventually being invited aboard the
