The porcelain of Choisy-le-Roi in the 18th century is an extremely rare and little-known production except by specialists, often overshadowed by the great Parisian manufactures. This factory, located on the banks of the Seine, produced objects meeting the growing demand for tableware in the bourgeois and aristocratic society of the time. The
