Superb and rare fountain project by Gaston-Aimé DUMONT (1899-1984). He was a sculptor and statuery, he is found in the inventory of French culture for a life-size work entitled "the Duchess of Galliera". There is also a model named "Jesus. Host" dated 1936. There is also a book that describes Gaston-André (or Gaston -Aimé) DUMONT (BEAUMONT in Argonne because he was born in the Ardennes) as making sculptures, bas-reliefs, monuments etc.... which confirms that he was indeed a sculptor and plastic artist. As for this fountain project, it represents a young woman completely naked placing her right foot on the head of a mask resting on steps. The water was to spring from this mask. Very beautiful architectural element, with characteristic forms of the period as well as the hairstyle of the young
