Description

Elegant Venetian side table, dating from the Charles X period (c.1830), crafted in cherry wood with a refined quartered veneered top. At the centre is a rich ebonised marquetry decoration, with stylised floral motifs reminiscent of lilies and ornamental scrolls, framed by a circular pattern of strong visual impact. The top, measuring 64 cm in diameter, is bordered by a shaped frieze featuring a distinctive workmanship of small vertical elements applied in succession, creating a rhythmic decorative effect. Discreetly concealed beneath the frieze is a practical drawer, perfectly integrated into the structure. The central support stands out for its slender and elegant design: a turned, partially ebonised shaft, from which three graceful scrolls branch out to support the top. The tripod base, ending with shaped feet,
