Short saber Aghan called khyber - Afghanistan, Pashtun, 19th century. Handle made of bone and horn plates and brass mount. Single-edged blade and T-section spine. Wooden scabbard covered with leather, animal skin and a large chiseled brass rivet. Former German private collection. Collected in situ in the early 1970s. One of the bone plates has a slight play because the top rivet is missing. Accidents and losses to the leather and animal skin of the scabbard. Cracks in the wood of the scabbard at the upper part. The whole remains solid. Total length 77.5cm Length without scabbard 72.5cm Blade length 59.5cm Weight 1065gr Weight without scabbard 673gr
