The dial, finely mounted in gilt bronze, features white enameled cartouches and delicately worked hands in the shape of serpents, adding a distinctive touch of refinement. The richly sculpted handles, together with the gilt bronze roccaille-style base, give the whole an opulent character, typical of the eclectic taste of the 19th century.
