Description

Flexible bracelet composed of two parts: links with floral motifs of generally round shape, richly worked with petals, set with rose-cut diamonds, the centers of which are adorned with a crowned rose-cut diamond in a setting characteristic of the period links with foliage motifs, more extensive, and openwork, also set with rose-cut diamonds and similarly adorned in their center with a diamond articulated between them, and resulting in a general cuff format. Dating from the Belle Epoque, end of the 19th century / beginning of the 20th, the base of the bracelet is made of 750/°° yellow gold (18 KT, owl hallmark) while the upper part set with diamonds is in silver (swan hallmark), which gives this jewel a very soft, subtle general color and gives it a beautiful relief. The overall theme being floral, the rosettes

evoke the classic daisy shape in jewelry, while the openwork links offer patterns evoking acanthus leaves, even on the ratchet clasp which is invisible to the wearer (secured by an additional safety chain). Particularly delicate and neatly finished, this bracelet offers a beautiful finish thanks to its chiseling and its delicately beaded setting edges.
