Description

Charles-Louis Müller (1815-1892) - Portrait of a Man, signed & dated 1838A pupil of Gros and later of Léon Cogniet, Charles-Louis Müller was a renowned portraitist of the Romantic generation. Here, he captures with rare psychological accuracy the presence of a Parisian man of letters: three-quarter bust, sustained gaze, contained half-smile, thin moustache and starched collar. The light concentrates the modeling of the face while the restrained background creates an almost confidential intimacy, giving the impression of a whispered exchange between painter and model. The work is most likely a private commission under the July Monarchy and retains traces of earlier interventions on the reverse (label R. Leyle, Bordeaux; workshop annotations "Camille", "Lassalle/Lasalle"). Old
