Small miniature inkwell in finely carved bone, with rich decoration of a deer on the top, as well as a doe lying in a grove, a hunting dog chasing a fox, and a rabbit on the side, old store label "Verdussen-Hermans - Montagne de la Cour 15 -Brussels", from the 19th century. This inkwell is in good condition, superb quality. It has its small elements see photos. Note: small accident and missing on one side, dirt and wear of time, see photos. \* This street, whose origins date back to the Middle Ages, was one of the major axes connecting the upper and lower parts of the city. Of the rue Montagne de la Cour, only a small section remains today just below the Place Royale. The rest has disappeared to make way for the Mont des Arts. This project, implemented in two phases (turn of the 19th-20th century,
