Argentine painter, theater designer and illustrator.

He studied with Ernesto de la Carcova and then went to Europe where he became a student of Francesc d'Assis Gali in Barcelona, and Désiré Roca in Paris. He was also a disciple of Herman Anglada Camarasa, a precursor of Fauvism who introduced him to the use of intense colors as well as the Baroque and Decorative styles. Later, he settled in Cala Sant Vicenç on the island of Mallorca where he painted the series dedicated to the Pine of Formentor and Cap Del Pinar, one of the three peninsulas of Mallorca. Upon his return to Argentina, he was appointed professor and set designer at the Cervantes and Colon theaters. He participated in various exhibitions: at the Salon de Otoño in Palma and at the Galerías Witcomb in Barcelona in 1931. In 1948, he was the subject of an exhibition at the Circulos de Bella Artes in Palma.
