Against a snowy background, several naked children are busy around a fire, accompanied by an attentive wolf, in a naive and mischievous atmosphere typical of the artist, a major figure of fin-de-siècle art.

Adolphe Léon Willette (1857-1926) Adolphe Willette was a French painter, illustrator, poster artist, and caricaturist. A student of Cabanel at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, he became a prominent figure in Montmartre artistic life at the end of the 19th century. He contributed to numerous satirical newspapers such as *Le Chat Noir*, *Le Rire*, and *L'Assiette au Beurre*, and was distinguished by his lively and expressive style, often tinged with humor and irony.
