Very fine sculpture and chiseling with a very beautiful medal-colored patina. Bears a foundry stamp and Gauquier's signature on the terrace. good condition, just an old restoration at the front of the arrow. Very beautiful rendering of the musculature and the expressive face with a slender wolf in the hunter's attitude. Attention: significant height and substantial weight! Henri Désiré Gauquié or Gauquier born October 22, 1858 in Flers-lez-Lille and died August 19, 1927 in Montfort-l'Amaury is a French sculptor.
