Georges STEIN (pseudonym of Séverin Louis Stein), 1864 / 1917 (French, of Luxembourgish origin) An urban landscape painter, watercolorist, draftsman, and illustrator, he is best known and recognized for his works depicting Paris and its streets, boulevards, and squares during the Belle Epoque. He was a student of Jules Lefebvre and Gustave Boulanger. Influenced by Jean Béraud, he worked in particular on the treatment of light to convey the hustle and bustle of Parisian life: his works are imbued with spontaneity, dynamism, and movement, giving viewers the sensation of participating in the scenes observed and the
